the first "V" denotes the bow of a small fishing boat, the second "double S" expresses both the beautiful Nagaragawa river and a pair of cormorants (they are in love with each other) the 3rd and 4th "MM" show the bridge across the river, the red circles denote the torch when fishing, and show dreams and passions of youth toward the future.
